## PCSO Crime Prevention Day

On the 19th June 2010 we held a Crime Prevention Day in the centre of the village. We gave out various types of literature ranging from Dog ownership to keeping your home secure. We also gave a few freebies like activity books and crayons to the children. The afternoon was a success with some 35 people stopping to chat with us. We use these days to determine what are priorities should be for the forthcoming months.

On 28/05/2010 Disley Community Action Team along with Fire Service carried out a Driver Engagement Day where motorists seen using a mobile phone, not wearing a seat belt or speeding through the village were pulled over to the side of the road and spoken to. In total 49 vehicles were stopped. The motorists were given a choice of a fine and penalty points or to watch then and there a presentation by the fire service which lasted between 20-30 minutes. The presentation included videos and pictures of what can happen when your either not wearing a seatbelt, speeding or on your mobile phone. In all 49 motorists watched the presentation. This particular event took place on Jackson's Edge Road, Disley but future ones look set to take place at various locations throughout

## Recent Incidents

### Anti-Social Behaviour

As the summer months approach we tend to see quite an increase in Anti-Social behaviour, this year it seems to have begun earlier than expected. Over the last 3 weeks we have been made aware of youths drinking and setting small fires down on Arnold Rhodes playing fields. We have also been made aware of some graffiti on the ball court near to the train station. If anyone has any information regarding the graffiti please contact on 0845 458 6371. Can we ask that if you do see youths acting anti-socially that you ring the non – emergency number as it is happening rather than reporting it the following day, its extremely difficult for ourselves to deal with the issue when we are not made aware until after the event.

### Suspicious Activity

We are receiving reports of suspicious vans in and around Disley, mainly looking in skips and gardens for scrap metal. We will continue to stop any vehicle we deem to be acting suspiciously but please make sure any metal you are not wanting to get rid of is not left insecurely outside your property.

### Working together

On 30th June we teamed up with trading standards to look at work being carried out on residents properties in Disley to make sure those working weren't on trading standards list of Rogue traders, happily I can confirm no companies working in Disley were found to be on their list.
